The core of the program consists in a series of lecture courses, individual lectures, and intensive text-based seminars. A Participants Conference will be held July 17-18, 2004.

Participants will be comfortably housed at Hotel Le Mura (\*\*\*) in the historic center of Città di Castello. The cost for room and board (full pension) will be approximately 51 euros/\$51 (double occupancy) and 42 euros/\$42 (single room) per day. The program fee for the three-week session will be \$275.
